Dear Retired Teacher,

We are looking forward to our next ECRTA meeting on October 11, 2019 at the First Presbyterian Church of Huron. **Lunch begins at 12:00 noon.** Our speaker that day will be Dan Orzano from the Ohio Department of Commerce. His topic will be “*Avoiding Scams.*” Also, at this meeting, the Erie County Health Department will give flu shots to those who want them.
